Our training workshops aim to raise awareness of:

- Honour Based Violence (HBV)
- Forced Marriage
- Female Genital Mutilation (FGM)
- Faith Based Violence (FBV)
- Other forms of harmful practices

---

We will build competence amongst professionals and practitioners in order to help them identify and support women and girls who are at risk, or are likely to be at risk of experiencing harmful practices.

Training is open to all frontline practitioners including, Police; Education, Early Years, Youth and Children's Services; Social Workers; Health Visitors; Midwives; Housing, Faith and Voluntary Sectors.

### After training, professionals will be able to:

- Outline the different forms of harmful practices.
- Identify the risk factors that can render women and girls vulnerable to harmful practices.
- Identify the signs that a woman or a girl is at risk of, or experiencing, harmful practice/s.
- Describe the legislative and policy frameworks that exist for the prevention of harmful practices, the safeguarding of women and girls and the prosecution of the perpetrators.
- Outline the roles and responsibilities of different agencies in relation to intervention, safeguarding and enforcement.
- Identify key referral pathways.
